American Association of Safety Councils Scholarship

\$500 per year Maximum

The "*American Association of Safety Councils Scholarship*" is a maximum scholarship of \$500 per year. Eligibility:

- ♦ Any employee or family member of an AASC Safety Council or any individual, whose parent, or legal guardian, is employed at an AASC safety council for a period of not less than twelve months.
- ♦ Any member or family member of an AASC Safety Council who has been a member of not less than twelve months.

The scholarship applicant must be a full-time student in the sophomore level or higher at an accredited college or university. The person must have a 2.75 GPA or higher and will be selected by the Scholarship Committee based on an essay relating how safety and health are important in their life and career.

Application deadline is June 15, 2007 to be considered for the *2007 American Association of Safety Councils Scholarship*.
